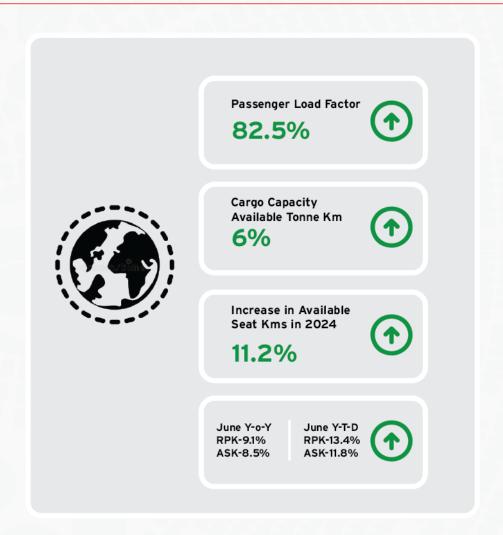


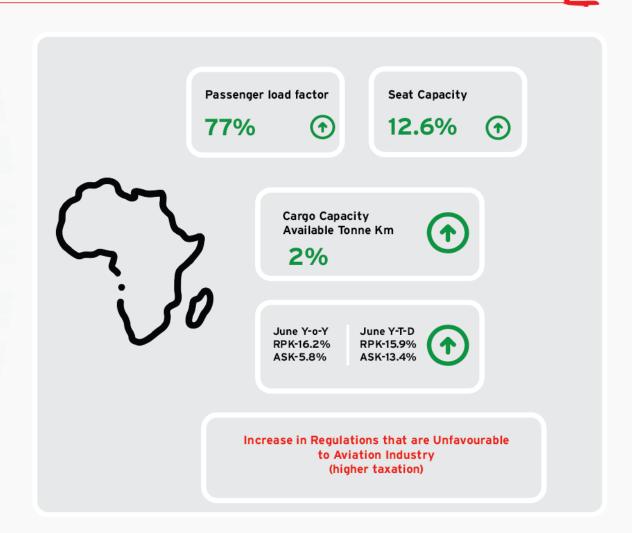

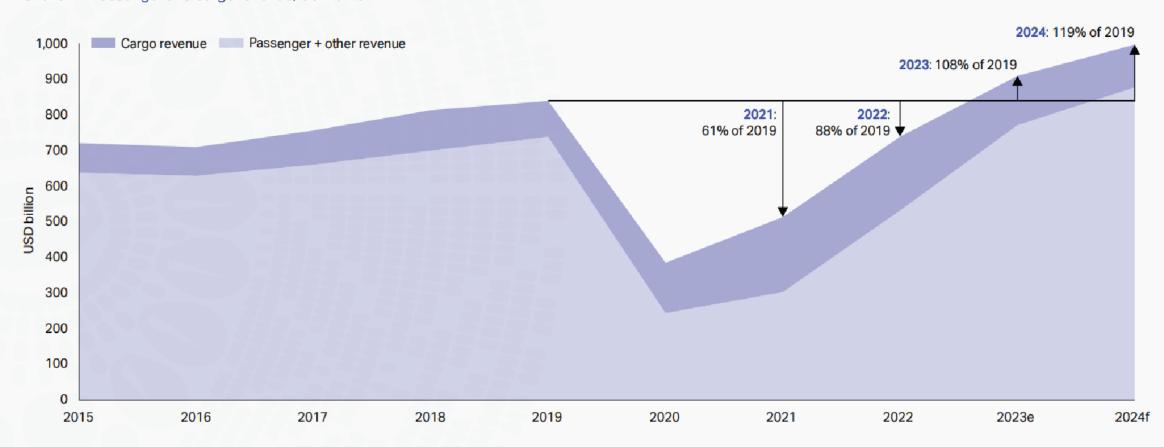






Passenger and Cargo Revenue forecast

Chart 22: Passenger and cargo revenue, USD billion

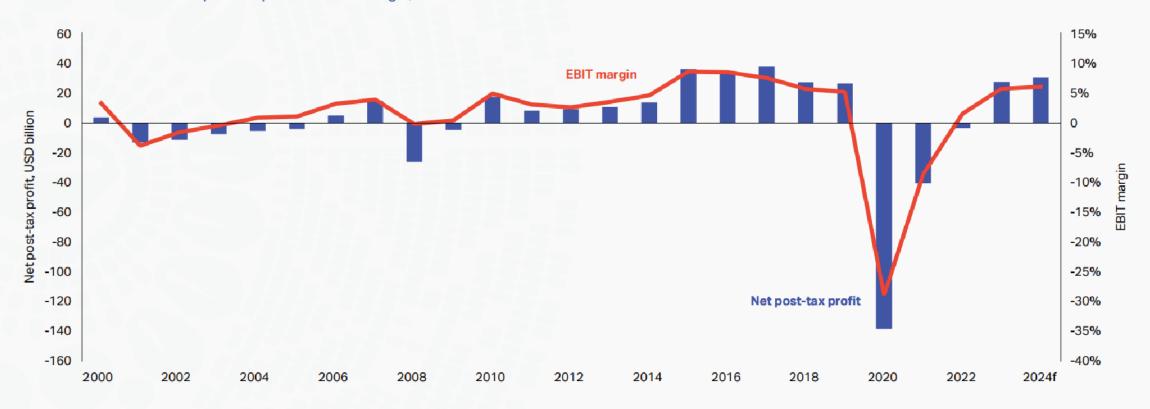

Factors Affecting Aviation Prospects



- **Economic Pressures:** High crude oil prices, strong USD, persistent inflation, and higher interest rates.
- **Global Voting Impact:** Elections in 70 countries (4.2 billion voters), influencing global economic activity.
- Policy Volatility: Uncertainty from political transitions.
- **Post-COVID Recovery:** Return to Industry profitability as traffic matches 2019 levels.

Critical Contextual Issues: Some Positive Outlook



- **Traffic Recovery:** RPKs have returned to 2019 levels; 11.6% growth in RPKs and 0.4% increase in global passengers expected.
- **Regional Insights:** Africa is projected to see a contraction in passenger numbers, despite a strong 2023.
- **Air Cargo:** 5% growth anticipated, but faces trade policy restrictions and manufacturing trends.
- Revenue Growth: Industry revenue to increase by 10%, nearing USD 1 trillion.
- **Profitability:** Net profits projected at USD 30.5 billion, with a 3.1% net profit margin and 6.0% operating margin.
- **Profit Margins:** Slim margins make profitability vulnerable to rising costs and climate challenges.
- City Pairs: Unique city pairs expected to grow by 5% YoY, surpassing 22,000.

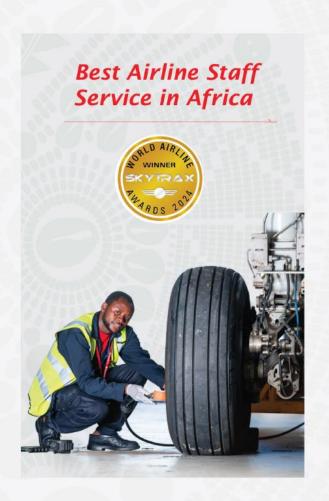

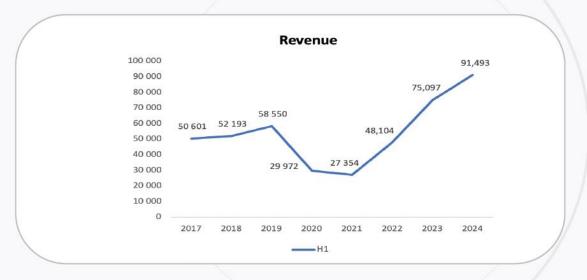






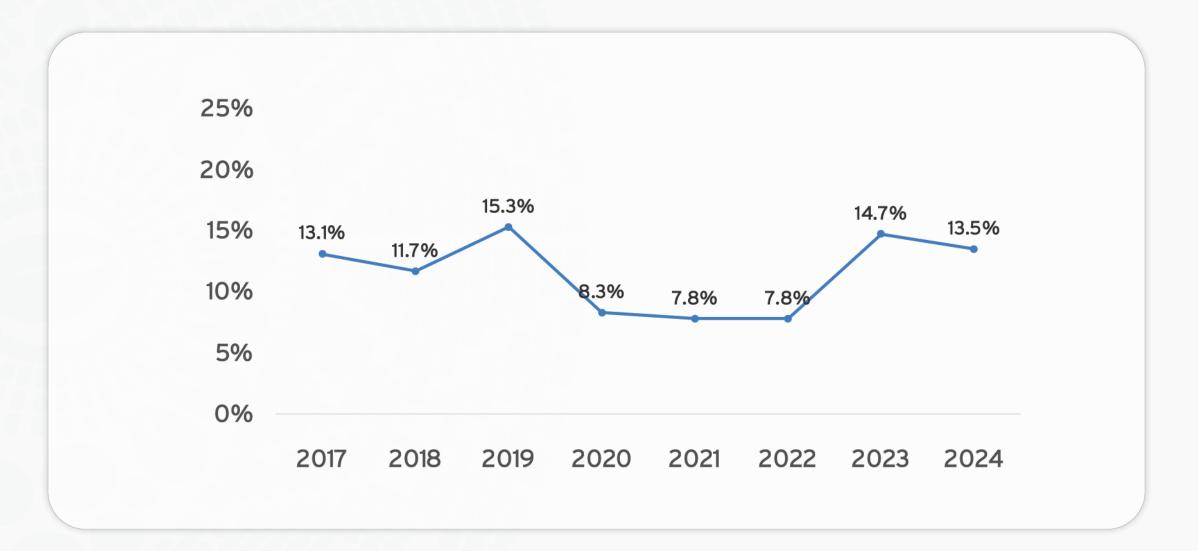
Revenue Trend: Half Year 2017-2024 Kshs. Mil

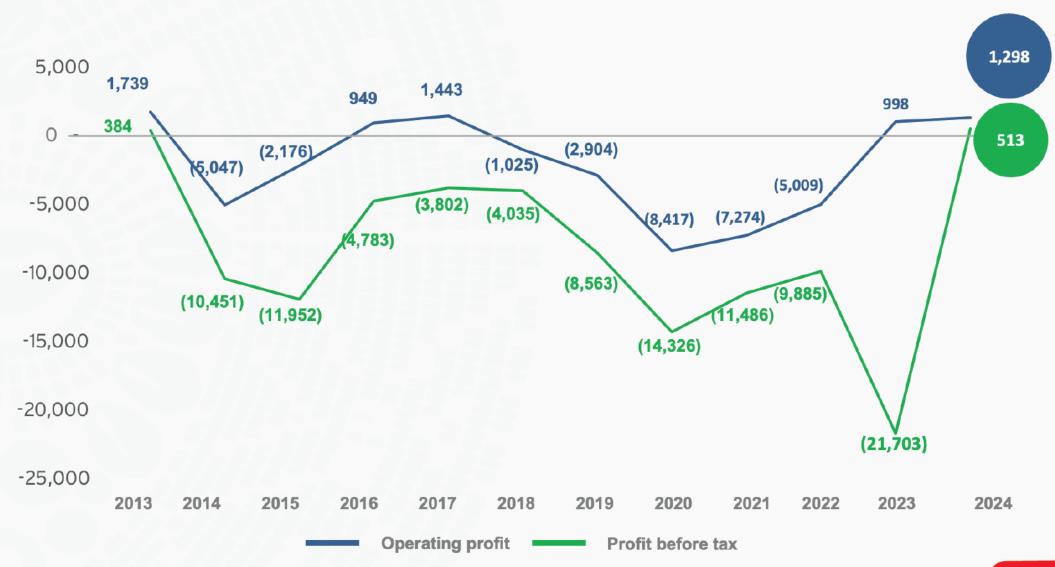
