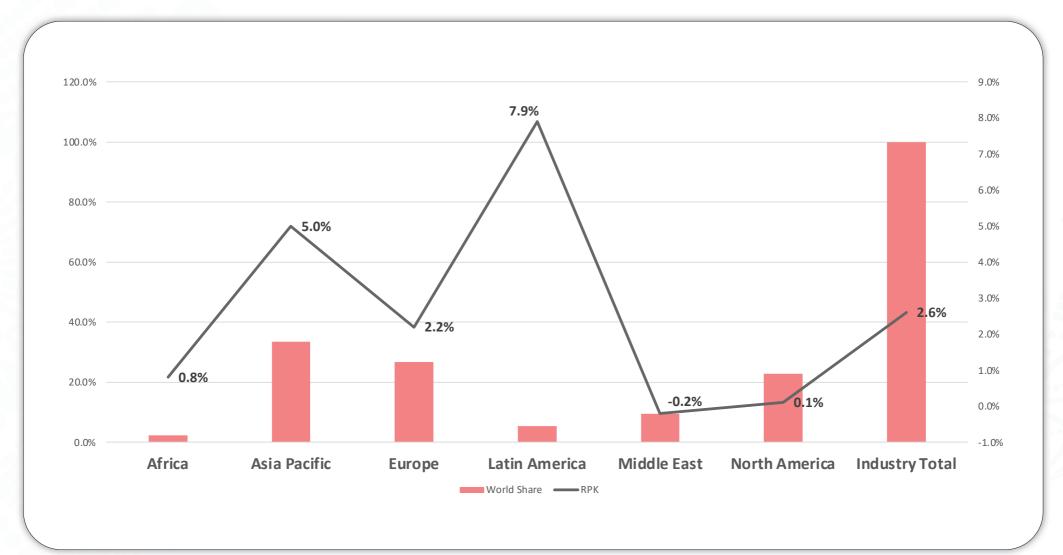

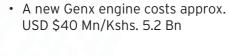


- Demand for Original Equipment spare parts is currently
 10-20% higher than supply.
- Lead times for avionics parts increased by 20%, with overall spare parts delivery disruptions affecting 40% of airlines.
- Recovery from disruption 45-90 days.



Aircraft Availability

- A new B787 Dreamliner costs approx. USD \$248Mn/Kshs. 32Bn at the current exchange rate.
- 14% of the global fleet is parked.



• A GEnx engine overhaul costs

approx. USD \$15Mn/Kshs. 1.9Bn

• Engine overhaul taking 90-120 up

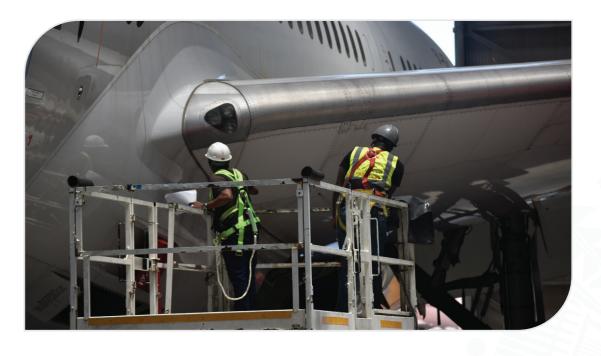
Operational Updates



Boeing 737-800 to our fleet

We welcomed a Boeing 737-800 to our fleet, increasing our aircraft count to 42.

This expansion boosts our capacity, enhances efficiency and strengthens our network to serve our guests better.

- First of the three returned to service in July 2025, with the remaining two expected to return to operation later in the year.

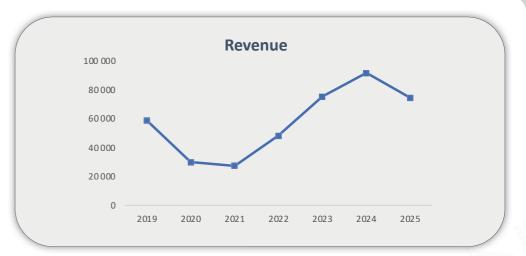




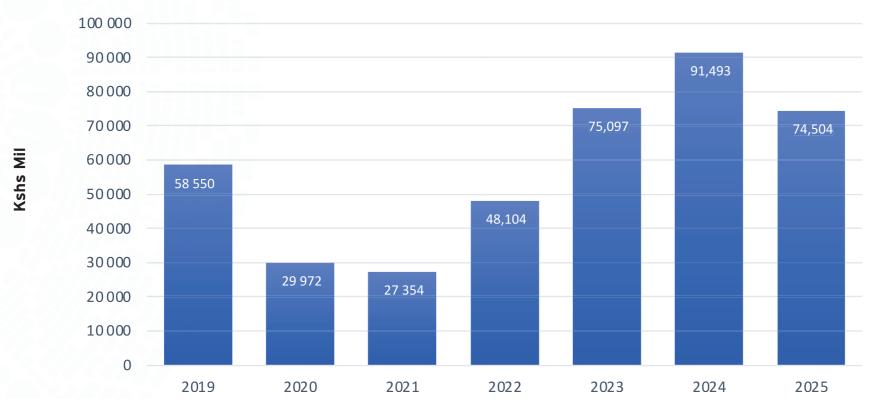




Turnover Trend

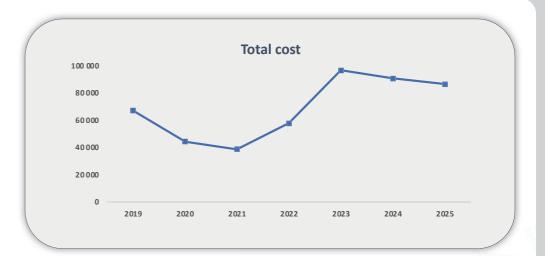


Revenue

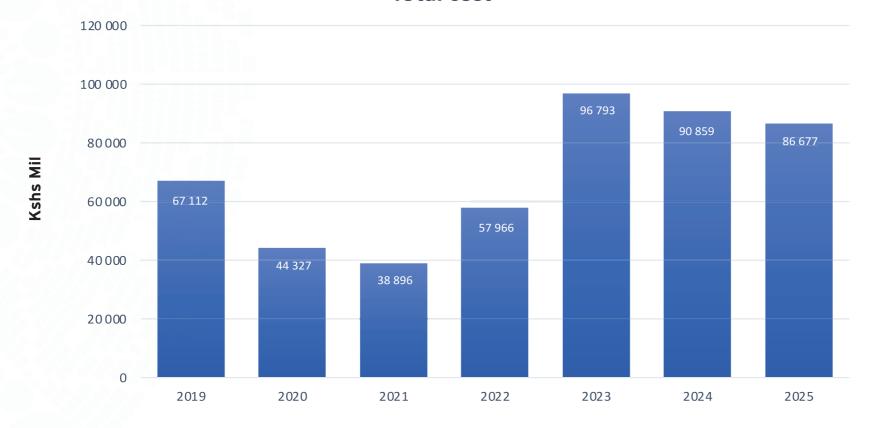




Cost Trend

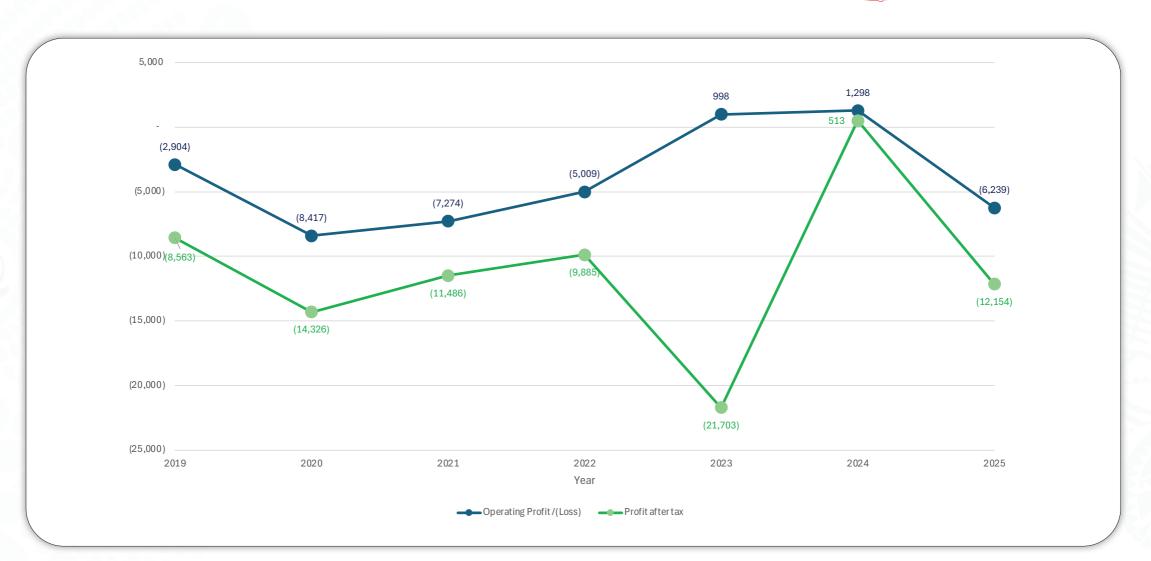

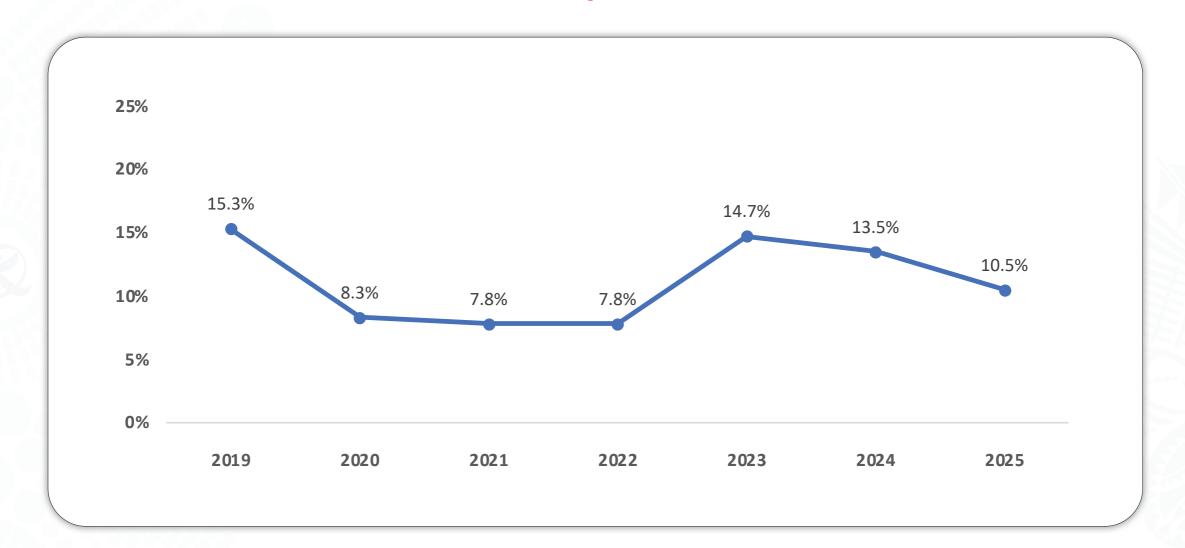


HY Operating & Net Loss/Profit Trend: Ksh Mil
