



POSITION STATEMENT

KQ 606 FLIGHT CABIN PRESSURE INCIDENT

Kenya Airways PLC (KQ) confirms that on 12th January 2023, at around 14:40hours, KQ 606 flight on routine flight from Nairobi to Mombasa experienced low cabin pressure. Our crew immediately declared pressurization failure emergency through air traffic control and descended to a safe altitude of 10,000 feet after briefing the passengers. The passenger oxygen masks were deployed for the safety of our passengers during the descent. The aircraft landed safely in Mombasa.

We sincerely apologise to our guests for the inconvenience and assure them that their safety and that of our crew is our highest priority. The aircraft has been grounded and investigation on the incident is ongoing.
